Driveway Repair - Capital Repair Update:

In the next couple of weeks, the Riverside Dr. end of the church driveway will be reconstructed and paved to improve the drainage. The cost of this project will be \$10,800, plus tax. There are some funds available to cover this cost, but not enough. Donations towards this project would be welcome - a square meter costs \$65. (186 square meters!)

The other priority project for 2018 is roof repair on the CE wing of the building. Estimates are being gathered and some of the proposed solutions are below the initial estimate of \$45,000.

Chancel Renovation:

Another project on the capital improvement list is making the chancel (pulpit/organ/altar area) more accessible and adaptable. Some work has been done to develop ideas, but this project needs development. A gathering will be held on Tuesday, May 29th at 7pm to discuss ideas and the next steps, please come along.
